



APPLICANT DECLARATION

Super Priority Visa Service

The Super Priority Visa Service (SPV) is available to applicants in the Philippines with no qualifying criteria (for Non – Settlement).

This optional service aims to process applications within 24 hours and incurs an additional fee of PHP _____ on top of the standard visa fee. The service is only available to those applying at the Manila visa application centre.

Terms and Conditions

- It is strongly recommended that applicants with any form of adverse immigration and/or criminal history do not use our Super Priority Visa service. This includes anyone who has previously been refused a visa for the UK, been refused leave to enter the UK, been previously deported, removed or otherwise required to leave the UK, has overstayed a period of leave in the UK, or has been refused leave to remain in the UK by UKVI.
- Using the Super Priority Visa service does not imply or guarantee that a visa application will be successful as all customers must still meet the requirements of the UK immigration rules.
- The Super Priority Visa service is not a guaranteed service. We do not guarantee that your application will be processed or that your passport will be returned within the period specified. For that reason, we strongly advise that you do not make travel or any other plans that are contingent upon our compliance with that timescale. Neither the Home Office nor its commercial partners will be responsible for any loss incurred as a consequence of failure to comply with the timescale.
- If you have previous names or a second nationality please note that we will not be able to process your application on the day that you apply. You can still apply for the Super Priority Visa Service and, whilst we should still be able to meet the 24 hour time-scale, we cannot guarantee this.
- The Super Priority Visa service fee will not be refunded if the visa is refused.
- The Super Priority Visa service as well as the application fee, is not refundable if your visa application is refused. If UKVI are unable to process a Super Priority Visa application within 24 hours they will advise you when a decision can be expected and whether the Super Priority Visa fee will be refunded.
